Suggestion 1:

The first suggestion was to intensify the orientation BESTCare system, recommending the dailv throughout the 5-day program. sessions Thev department - Outpatient, that each proposed Inpatient, and Clinical—contribute specific sessions to the orientation. These department-led sessions provide deeper, would a more practical understanding of the various pharmacy practice areas, including ambulatory clinics outpatient intravenous admixture pharmacy, room. inpatient satellites among other areas. The goal was to ensure that R1 pharmacy residents have a well-rounded introduction to the diverse aspects of pharmacy they will be covering during residency.

Suggestion 2:

Another suggestion was to enhance the research component of the residency program. One key recommendation was to facilitate early registration in postgraduate research courses at the start of each year. This would give residents the opportunity to develop their research skills and start planning their residency projects promptly. Additionally, they recommended the introduction of a dedicated research course to specifically support their residency-related research initiatives.

These proposed changes aim to improve the residency learning experience and foster a more comprehensive and effective training environment for future pharmacy professionals.
